Weekly Review

- Patrol responded to a Traffic Accident on Kenrick Avenue. One driver, a 48-year old male, was found impaired, providing a .22 breath test. He was jailed on DWI charges.
- Car Theft was reported on Kenyon Avenue, only to have the reporting party call back indicating it hadn't been stolen. The car was just covered in snow and hadn't been noticed in the lot!
- Officers responded to no less than nine (9) Mental Health Crisis calls.
- Patrol responded to a vehicle stuck in a snowbank at Holt Avenue and 209th Street West. The 28-year old male driver was found intoxicated and arrested for 2nd Degree DWI after providing a .33 breath test.
- Fraud activity reported after the victim met a male on a dating website. He told her he could only communicate via text message. As the text messages continued, he began asking for money for various reasons. The victim aided in the form of gift cards and wire transfers totaling over \$30,000.00.
- Officers worked with Homeland Security to take a 26-year old male into custody. He thought he was arranging to have relations with a 14-year old girl. Unbeknownst to him, he was flirting with three officers.
- Officers arrested a 43-year old male on an outstanding 3rd Degree Criminal Sexual Conduct Warrant.
- Officers responded to a Domestic/Disputes in Progress and arrested a 37-year old male for Domestic Assault, Strangulation and Threats of Violence.
- Theft reported at 21XXX Heron Way. A vehicle's tires and radio went missing.
- Traffic Stop at Dodd Boulevard and Hayes Avenue found the 40-year old female driver impaired. She was jailed for 3rd Degree Refusal, 4th Degree DWI and a host of other charges.
- Traffic Accident at 11XXX 210th Street West after the driver indicated his brakes failed, causing him to drive into the business. The glass and frame were broken, causing several thousand dollars' worth of damage. Fortunately, there were no injuries.
- Traffic Stop on Cedar Avenue resulted in the 4th Degree DWI arrest of a 23-year old female after she provided a .14 breath test.
