Weekly Review

- Officers responded to multiple Domestic or Assault calls:
 - A 9-1-1 Hang-Up resulted in the arrest a 32-year old male for 3rd Degree Assault and Interfere with 9-1-1.
 - Officers responded to an Assault report and arrested a 37-year old male for 3rd Degree Assault.
 - Officers responded to a Domestic/Disputes in Progress and arrested a 22-year old male for Domestic Assault.
 - Officers responded to a Domestic report and arrested a 24-year old male for 5th Degree Domestic Assault.
 - Officers responded to a Disturbance and encountered several intoxicated adults, a broken window and the suspect barricaded in the bathroom. A 28-year old female was jailed on Assault charges and Damage to Property.
- Two stolen vehicles were recovered, one reported stolen out of Burnsville and the other out of Minneapolis, after they had been left abandoned in two separate neighborhoods.
- Theft of license plates reported. The victim had her plates replaced after she thought they fell off the vehicle. She just received a ticket out of Texas on the missing plates.
- Patrol made several DWI arrests:
 - Traffic Stop at Ipava Avenue and Innsbrook Drive resulted in the DWI arrest of a 53-year old male.
 - Patrol responded to a Driving Complaint of a vehicle all over the road, almost striking several vehicles. The vehicle was located Kenrick Lakeville Liquors lot. The 29-year old female driver was impaired and arrested for 4th Degree DWI.
 - A vehicle in the ditch at I35 and Kenwood Trail resulted in the 2nd Degree DWI arrest of a 31-year old male.
- Theft from Vehicle reported from:
 - 9XXX 214th Street West. The victim parked her car, returning to find her window broken and a laptop and purse stolen.
 - 18XXX Dodd Boulevard
 - 17XXX Glacier Way. The car window was smashed and a purse was stolen.
 - Traffic Stop at Indiana Avenue and Dodd Boulevard resulted in the 3rd Degree DWI arrest of a 44-year old female.
 - Two separate thefts reported from 185th Street West and Kenrick Avenue. The vehicle owners reported the catalytic converters were stolen from their vehicle while parked at the Park & Ride.
- Patrol responded to no less than eight (8) Mental Health Crisis calls.
- Fraud Activity reported after the victim met an unknown female on a dating website and provided his bank account information to her. Since then, among many fraudulent actions, a loan was taken out in his name, fraudulent charges were made to his bank account, a new line of credit was opened and multiple credit cards applications are pending.
- Fraud Activity reported after the victim was sold a computer protection plan. Some time later, the "company" called and advised they would reimburse him money owed. After they claimed to accidentally reimburse him \$5,000.00, they asked he reimburse them in gift cards. He did, only to find he never received the reimbursement.
